

### **Odyssey of a Mother Country Radical**



Chuck Armsbury’s life has been—to say the least—one of trials and tribulations. In *Odyssey of a Mother Country Radical*, he recounts his journey from a childhood raised on a farm in Washington state, to a doctoral candidate & becoming heavily involved in the Sixties counter-cultural revolution, to imprisonment and a heretofore untold story of escape, harboring and murder.

An early marriage led to a variety of odd jobs to support his family—a laborer in a slaughterhouse, a carpenter, plumber, community college instructor, and gym operator. Through it all Chuck has lived by a creed of hard work that challenged the odds.

This book is a story of tenacity, bravery but often not prudence; it's funny, tragic, and undeniably honest.

“This is my memoir/autobiography. It took me almost 25 years to complete, repeatedly interrupted by other work. It's a big, 400 page history that's not well known or taught in schools with about 50 captioned photos in the middle.

“I have photos from birth, through my time at Green Acres schools, an early marriage in 1959, working as a butcher, into college, U of Oregon graduate school instructor, during prison, power lifting experience, 12 years as plumber and much more, including me pictured at St. Luke's Hospital after my leg amputation in May 2017.
