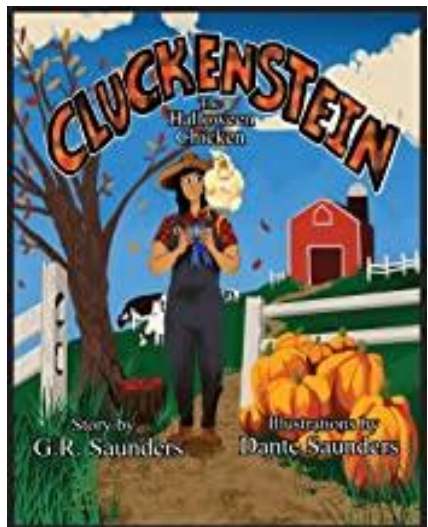

Cluckenstein: The Halloween Chicken

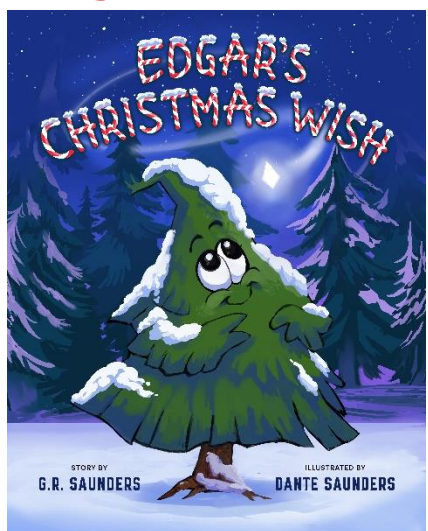
