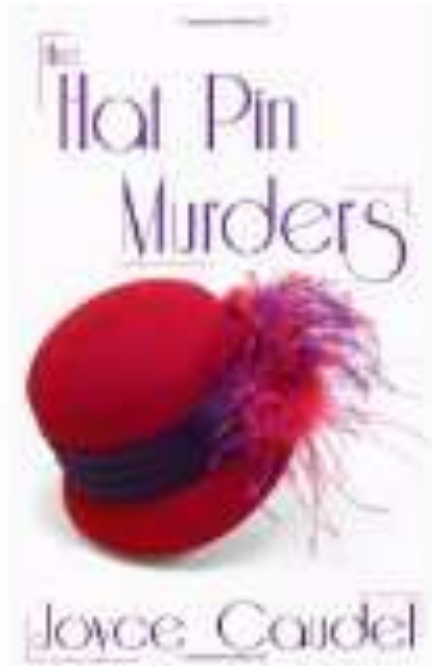

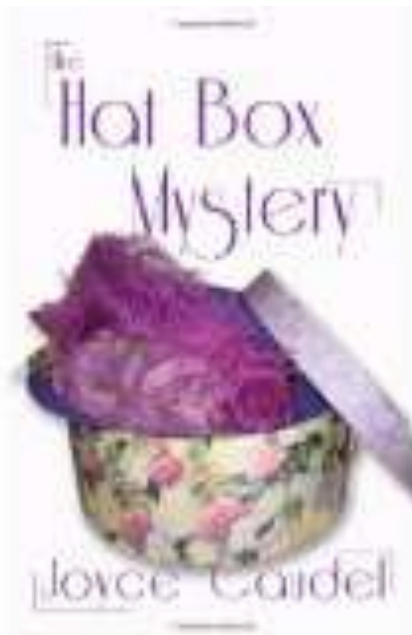
The Hat Pin Murders 1936178397 (paperback)

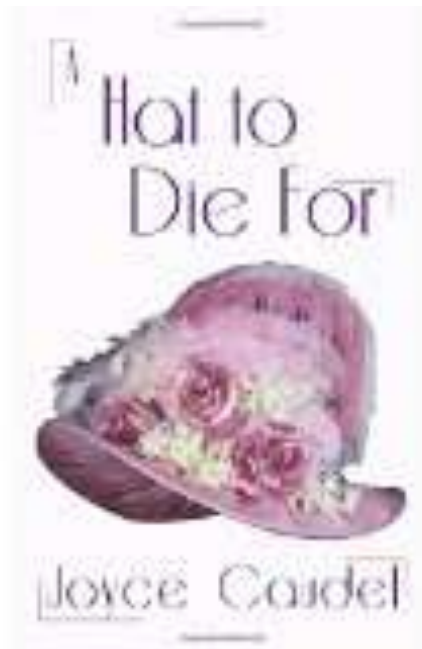


The Mystery Mamas are still all about having fun, dressing in their purple finest, sporting their feather boas and topping off their costume with an elegant red hat.
