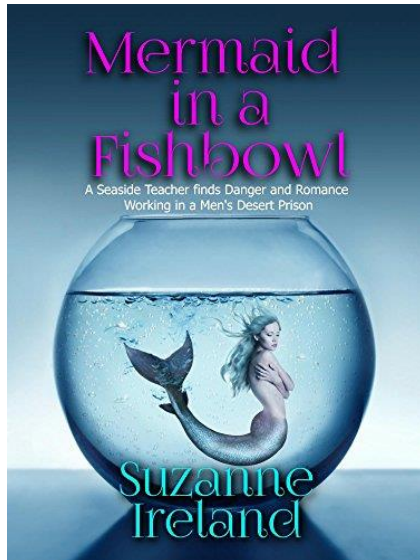
Suzanne Holland
