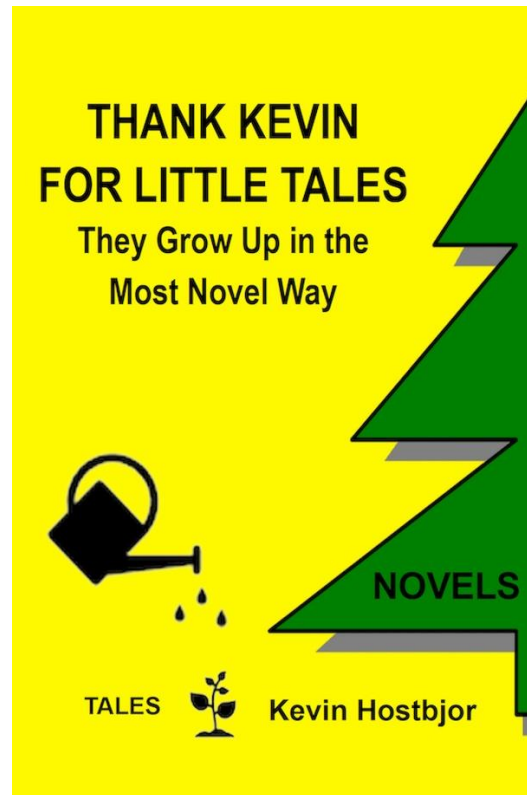


Thank Kevin for Little Tales: They Grow Up in the Most Novel Way
